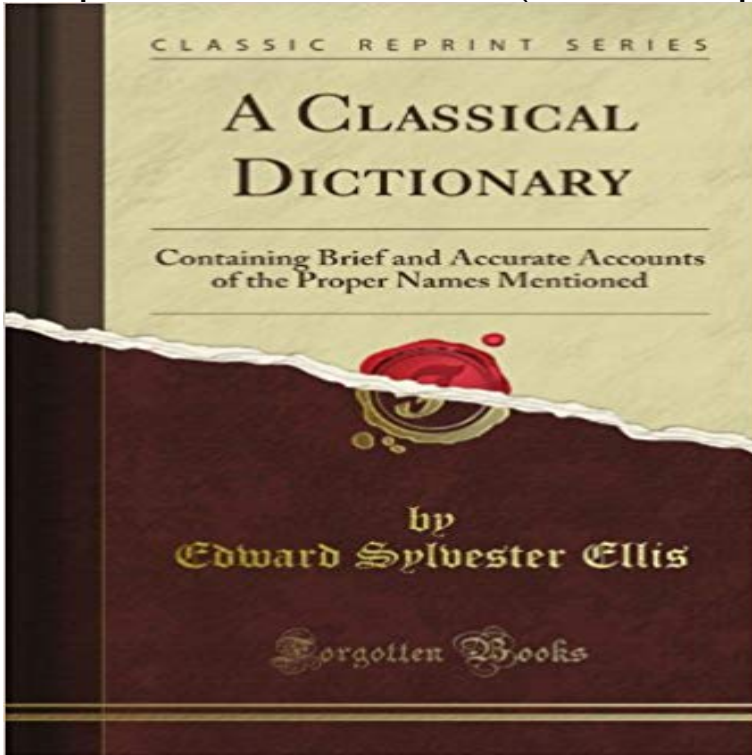


A Classical Dictionary: Containing Brief and Accurate Accounts of the Proper Names Mentioned (Classic Reprint)



The word classic or classical is defined as pure, refined; conformed to the best and most perfect standard; also pertaining to the ancient Greek and Latin authors, or rendered famous by association with ancient writers, as classic ground. The ancient Romans were divided into six classes. Those of the highest class were called *clarissimi*, and from this the term came to signify the highest and purest class of writers in any language, though at first applied only to the most esteemed Greek and Latin authors.
