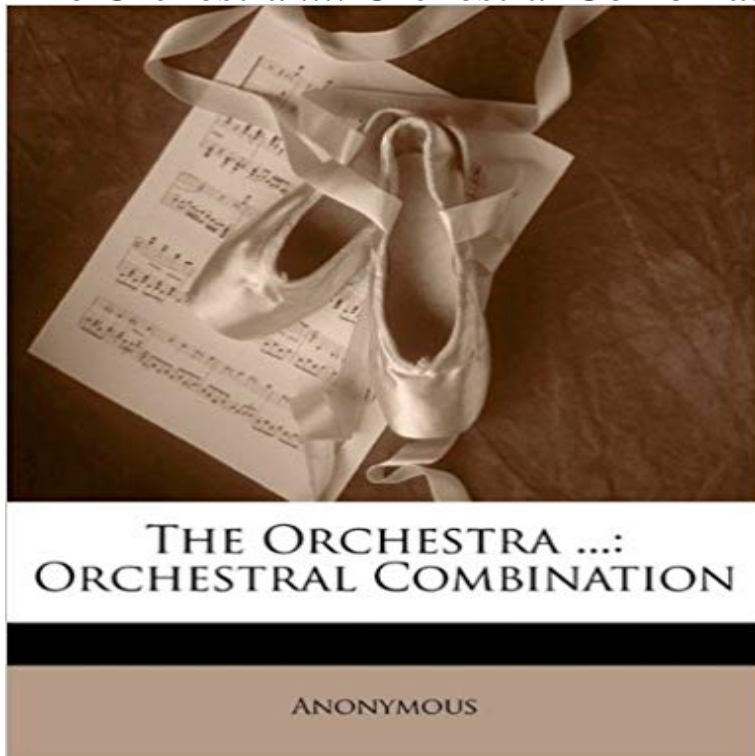


The Orchestra ...: Orchestral Combination
