Whether those Tables of the Altarfashion, which had been used in the Popilh tfmes, and on which Masses had been celebrated, should still be continued; This point was first started by Bishop Hooper, who in a Sermon before the King, in the fourth year of his reign, declared, That it would do well, that it might please the Magistrate to turn Altars into Tables according w to the first institution of Christ; to take ftway the false persuafion of the People, which they have of Sacrifice to be done upon the Altars: For as long (lays he) as Altars remain, both the ignorant People, and the ignorant and evil persuaded Priest will always dream of Sacrifice. This occasiond not only a couple of Letters from the King and Council, one of which was sent to all the Bishops and the other to Ridley Bishop of London (in both which they were requird to pull down the Altars;) but also that when the Liturgy was reviewd in iffi, the abovesaid Rubrick was alterd, and in the room of it the present one was inserted, viz. The Table having at the Communion-time, a fair, white, linen Cloth upon it shallstand in the body of the Church, or in the Chancel, where Morning and Evening Prayer are appointed to be j aid. And the Priest standing at the North side of the Table, shall fay the Lords Prayer with the Collet! following. But this did not put an end to the controversy. Another dispute arising, viz.
