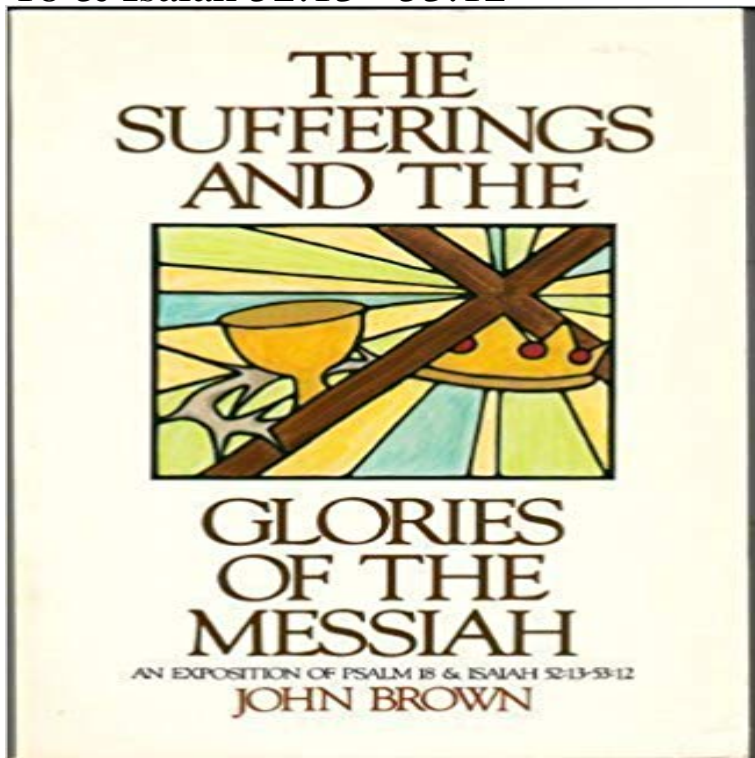


The Sufferings and the Glories of the Messiah: An Exposition of Psalm 18 & Isaiah 52:13 - 53:12
