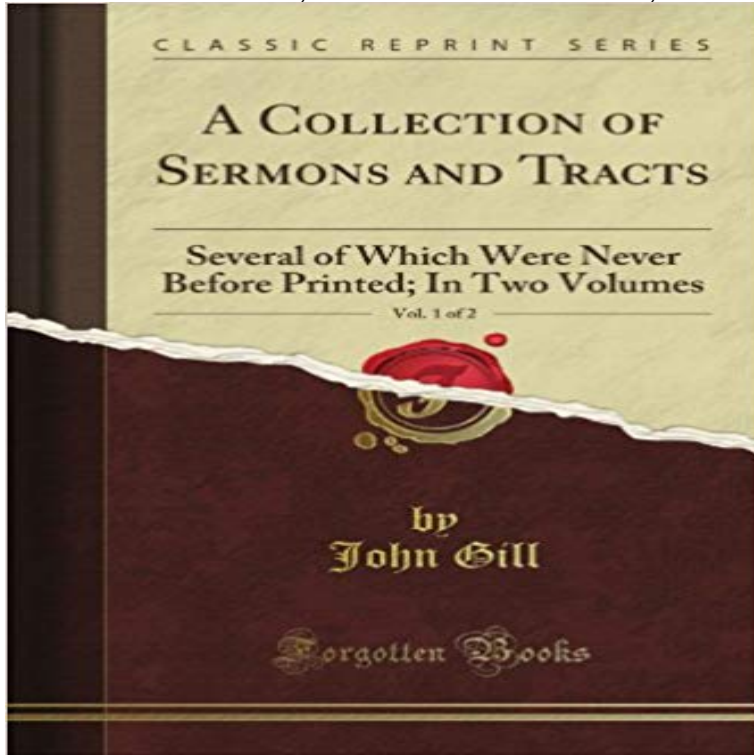

Thus the Woodman, who was reckoned a man of sobriety, honesty, and veracity, constantly and confidently affirmed at different times, without variation: and even years after when inquired of concerning it; nor could he have any finer end to avail himself of, in contriving such a story, and persisting in it. However, Mr Gill soon, as soon as he was capable of instruction, discovered a very great aptitude for learning, and imbibed it in as fast as it could be given: so that he was quickly out of the reach, and in no need of a common teacher of children. He was therefore sent to the grammar school, very early; which he attended with uncommon eagerness and diligence: inasmuch that he, soon, not only transcended his contemporaries, but distanced even greatly his seniors.
