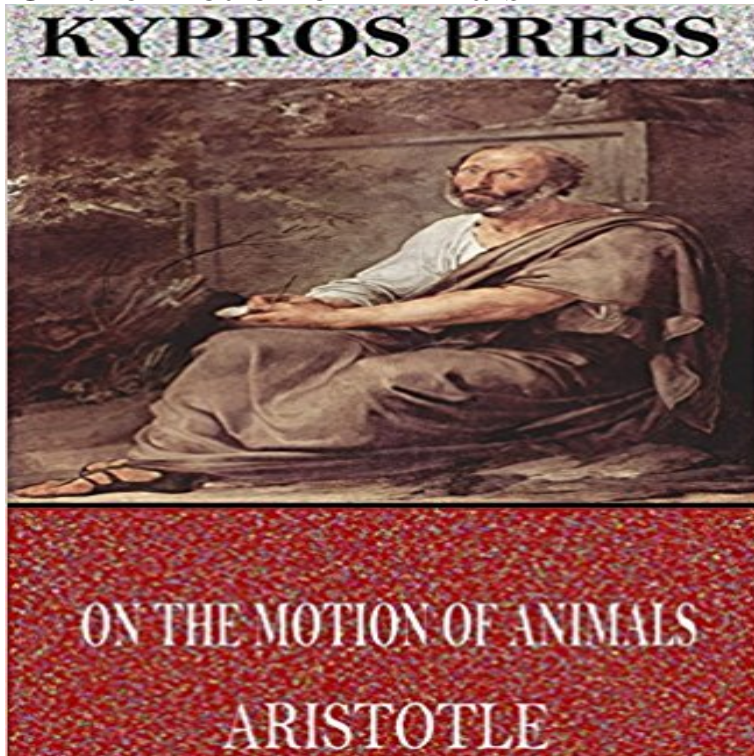


## On the Motion of Animals
