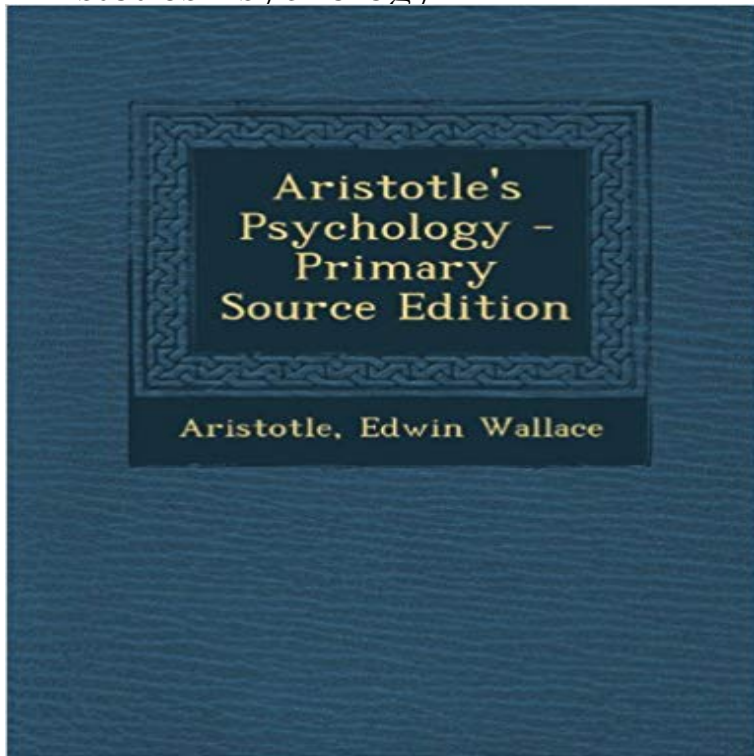


## Aristotles Psychology
