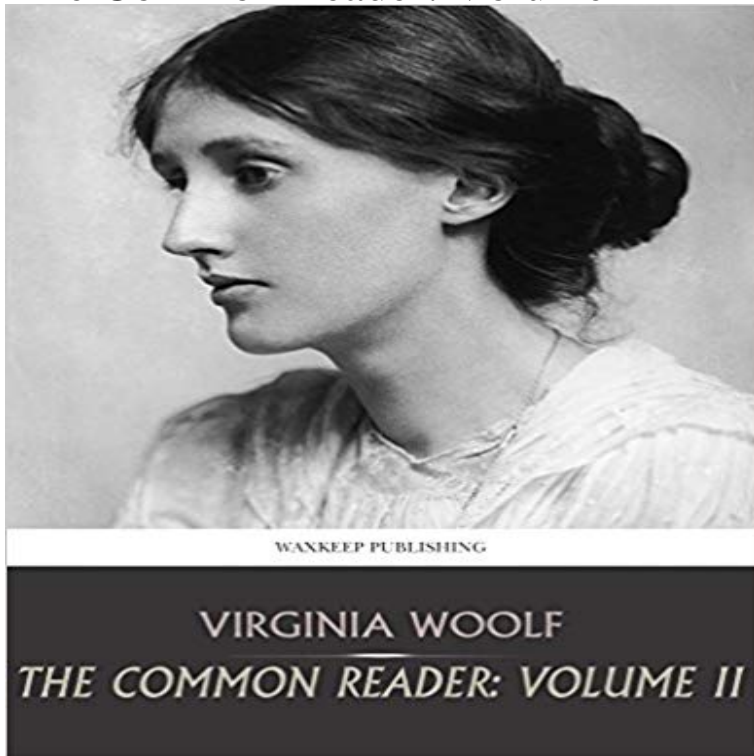


The Common Reader: Volume II
