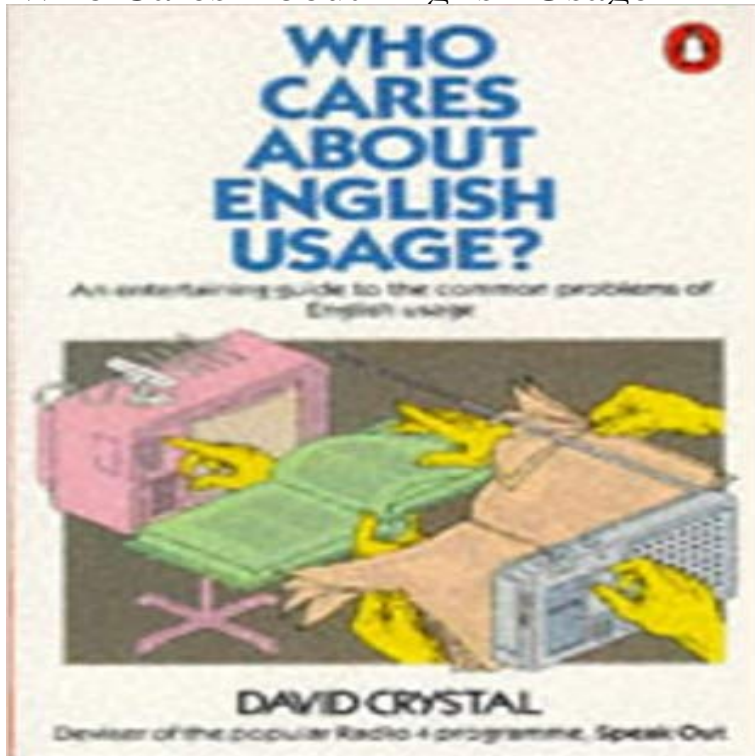


Who Cares About English Usage
