Ellery Queen is the pseudonym two cousins from Brooklyn used to write detective fiction. In their successful series, Ellery Queen served as both the authors name and that of the detective-hero. The cousins also cofounded Ellery Queens Mystery Magazine, considered one of the most influential English crime fiction magazines of the twentieth century. They were given the Grand Master Award by the Mystery Writers of America in 1961.
