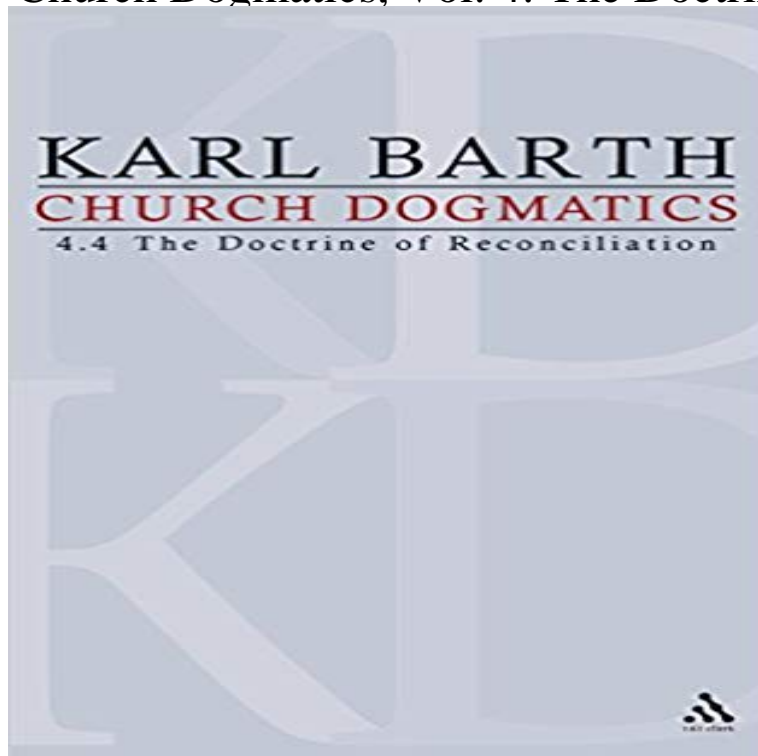


Church Dogmatics, Vol. 4: The Doctrine of Reconciliation
