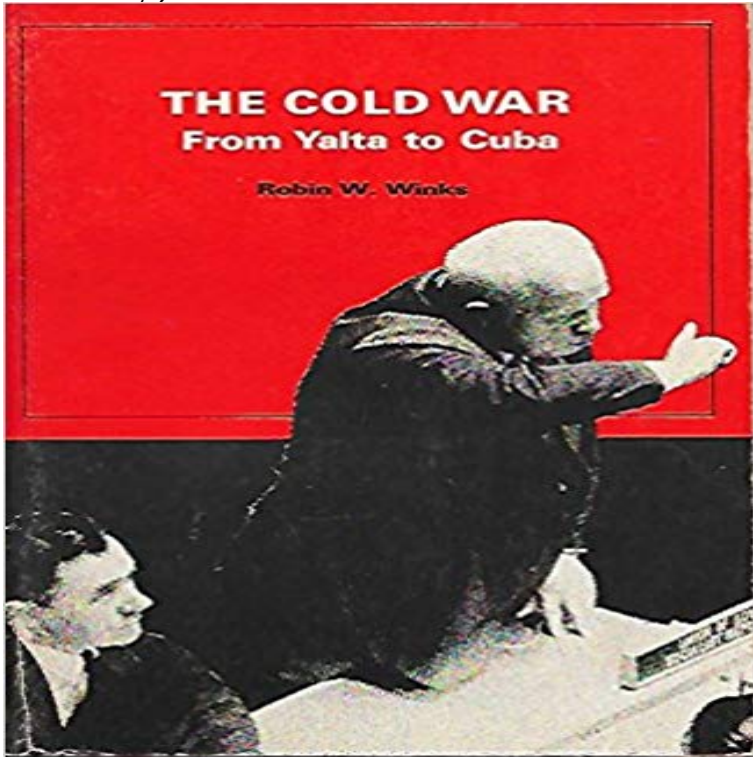


The Cold War from Yalta to Cuba (New Perspectives in American History)



In *The Cold War: From Yalta to Cuba*, Robin Winks provides a look at the background of the Cold War, a state of political and military tension which grew out of the Second World War and out of forces inherent in American and Russian history. Providing an informative and telling account of world affairs and the pulse of the times, Winks study begins with the Yalta Conference, and its ultimately failed agenda, and takes us through the global uncertainties preceding the Vietnam War. Winks, who died in 2003, was an historian and a professor at Yale University.
