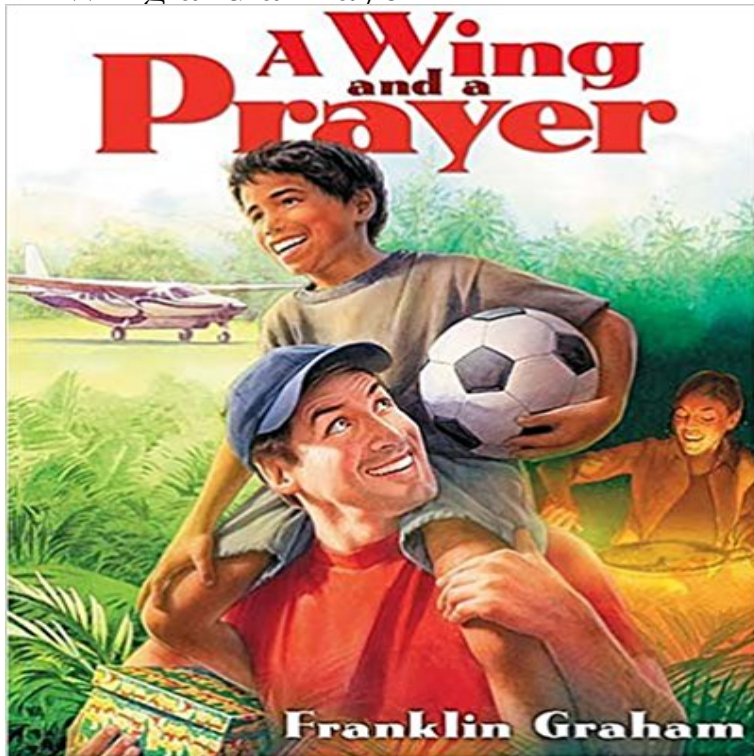


A Wing and a Prayer
