
Whose Body? (Deseret Alphabet Edition) (Deseret Alphabet Classics) (Volume 20)



Dorothy Leigh Sayers (18931957) was an English novelist, playwright, essayist, and translator. Her magnum opus, incomplete at her death, is her translation of Dantes Divine Comedy, which is still in print. Sayers is best remembered for her series of novels featuring the amateur detective, Lord Peter Wimsey, of which Whose Body? is the first. Although the mysteries themselves are ingeneous, Sayers greatest genius is in her richly-drawn characters and the detailed world they inhabit. The Lord mysteries are a fascinating examination of Great Britain between the two World Wars. This edition is in the Deseret Alphabet, a phonetic alphabet for English developed by the University of Deseret (now the University of Utah) in the 1850s and 1860s.
