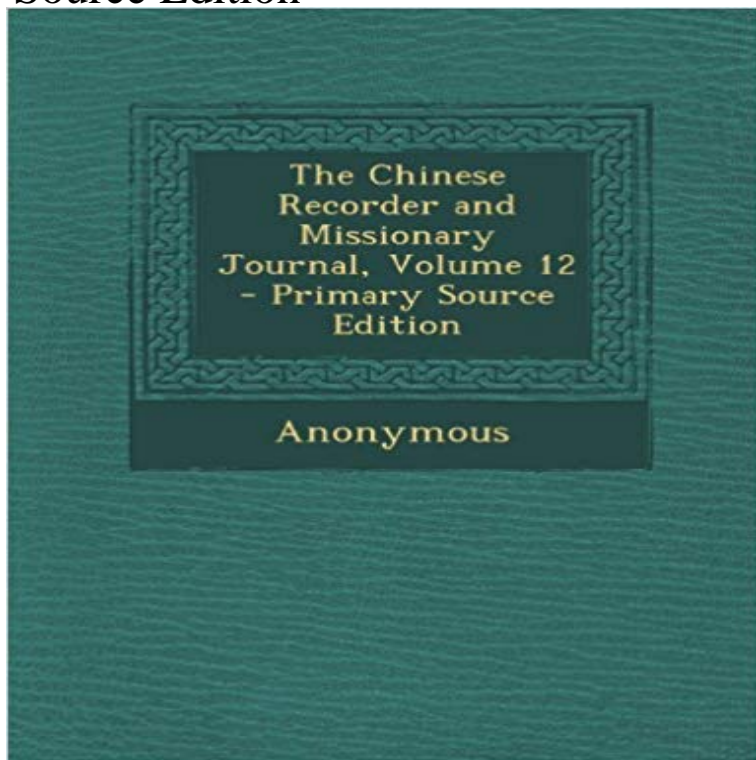


The Chinese Recorder and Missionary Journal, Volume 12 - Primary Source Edition
