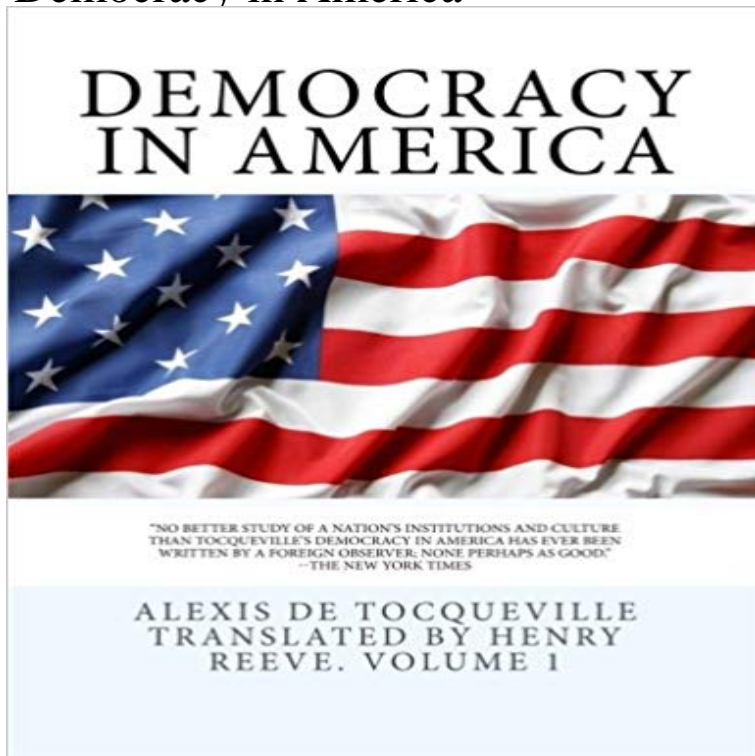


Democracy in America
