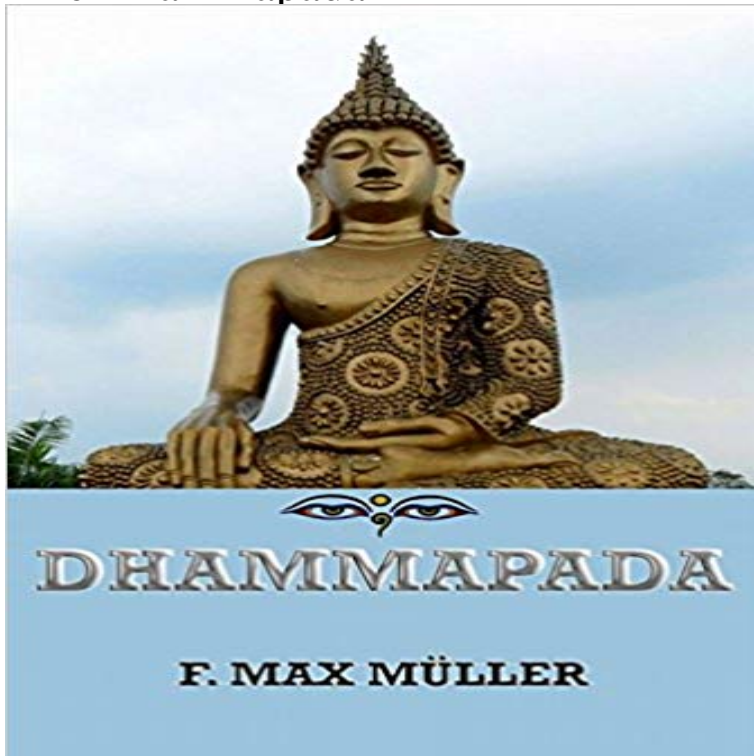


The Dhammapada



The Dhammapada is a versified Buddhist scripture traditionally ascribed to the Buddha himself. It is one of the best-known texts from the Theravada canon. The title, Dhammapada, is a compound term composed of dhamma and pada, each word having a number of denotations and connotations. Generally, dhamma can refer to the Buddhas doctrine or an eternal truth or righteousness or all phenomena; and, at its root, pada means foot and thus by extension, especially in this context, means either path or verse (cf. prosodic foot) or both.
