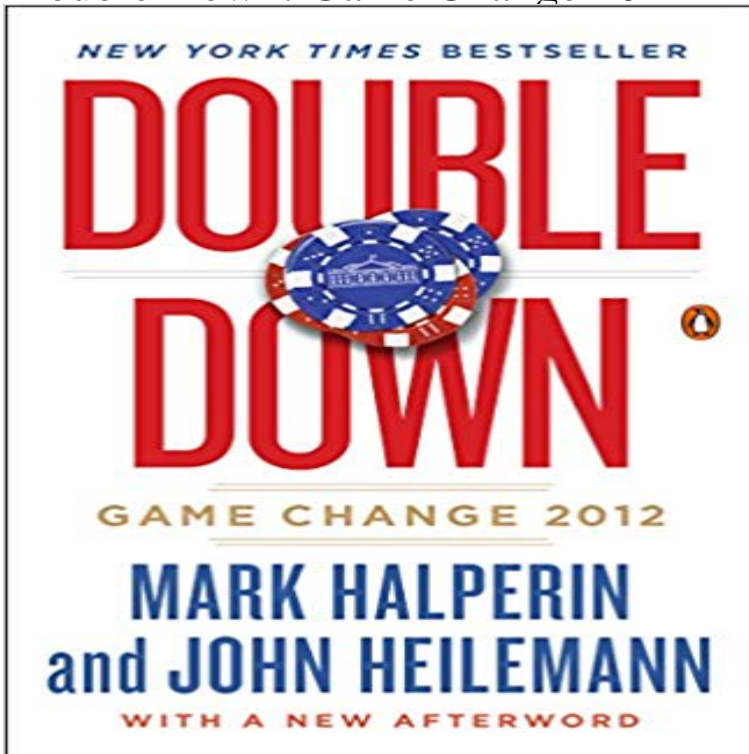


## Double Down: Game Change 2012
