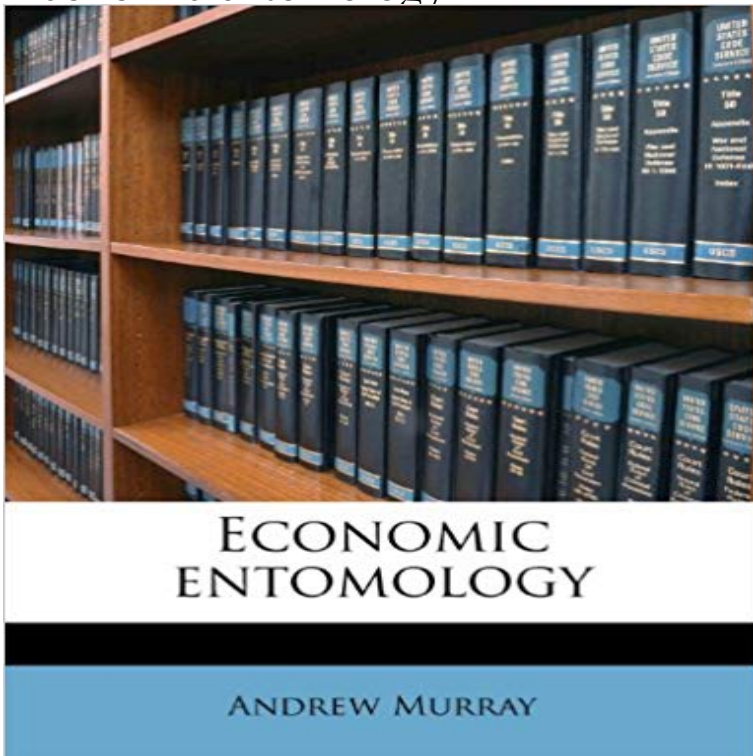


# Economic entomology
