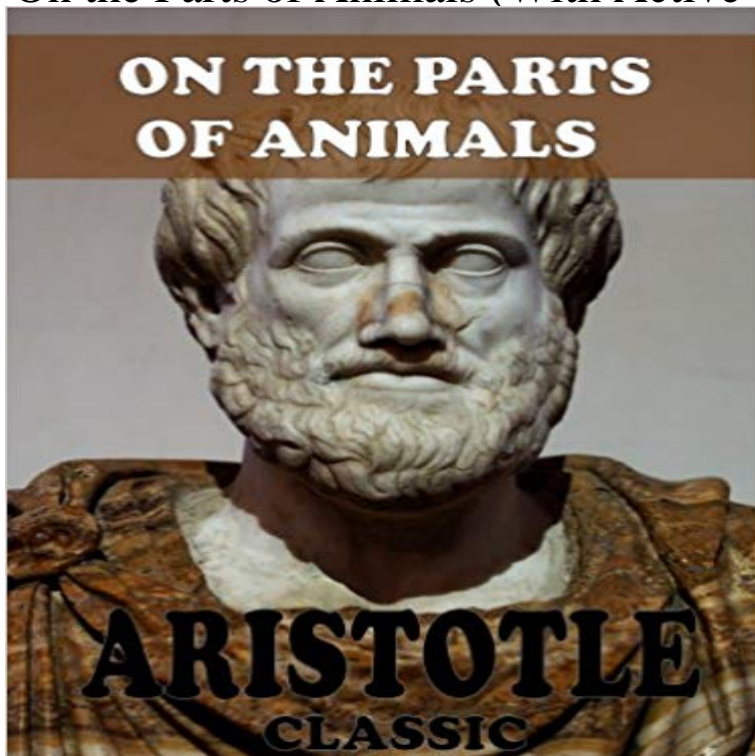


## On the Parts of Animals (With Active Table of Contents)
