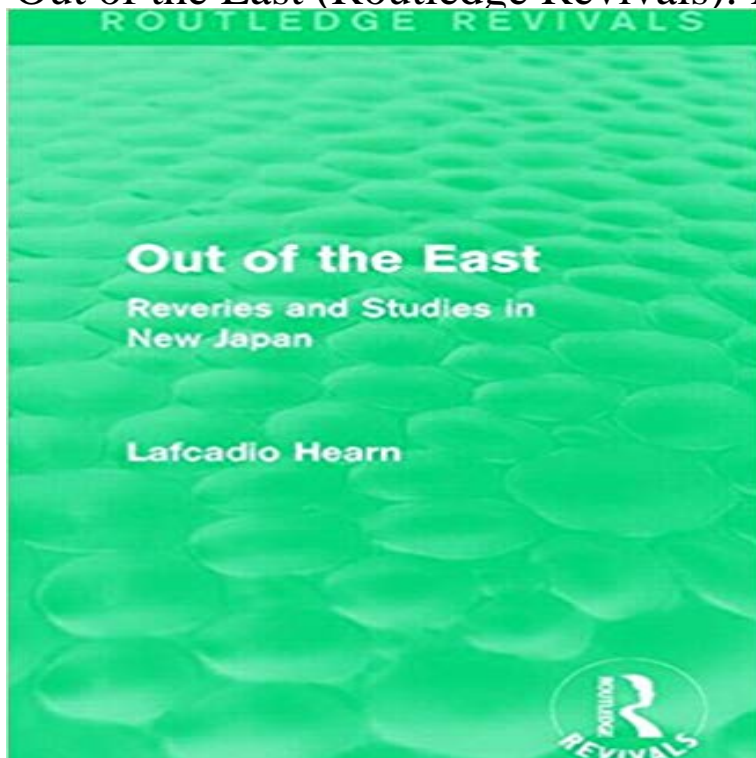


Out of the East (Routledge Revivals): Reveries and Studies in New Japan
