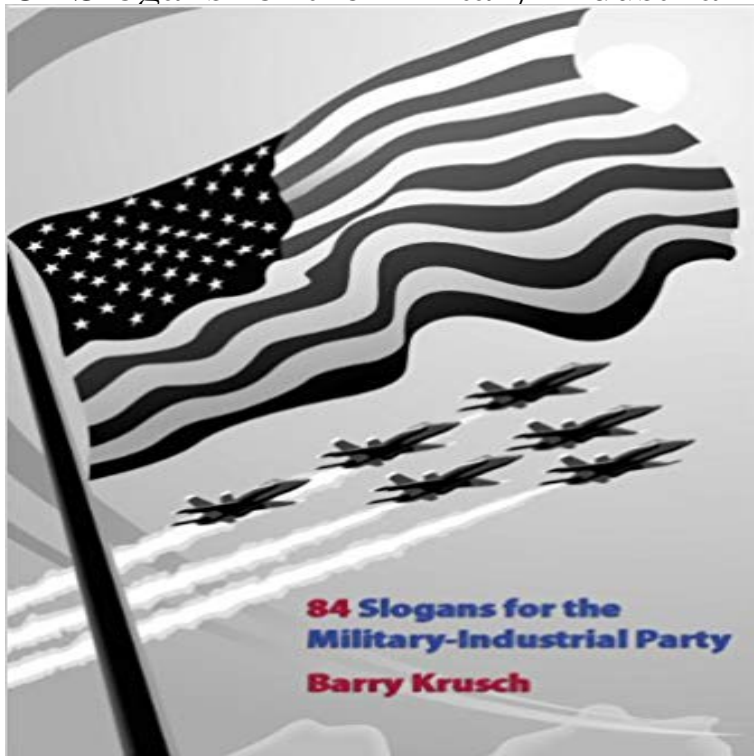


84 Slogans for the Military-Industrial Party
