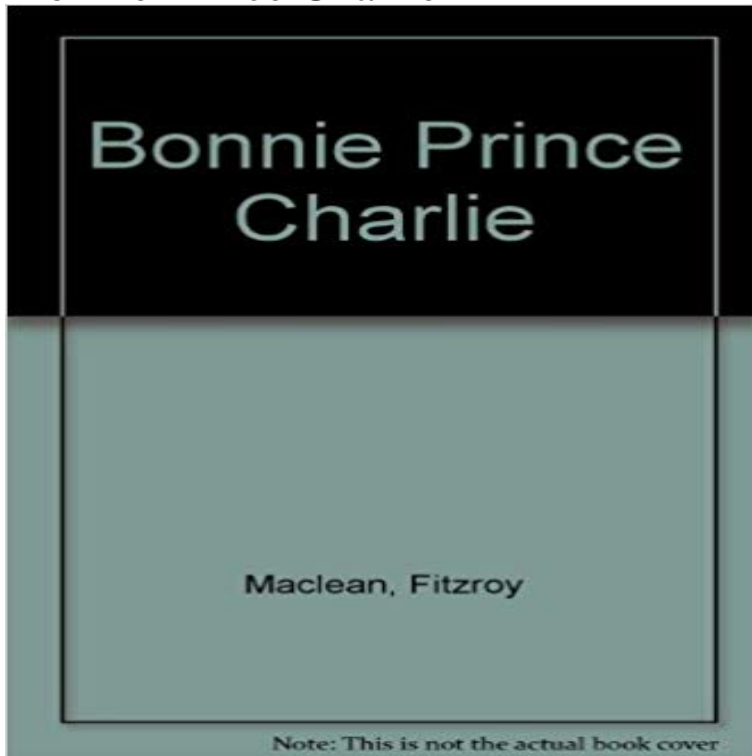


## Bonnie Prince Charlie
