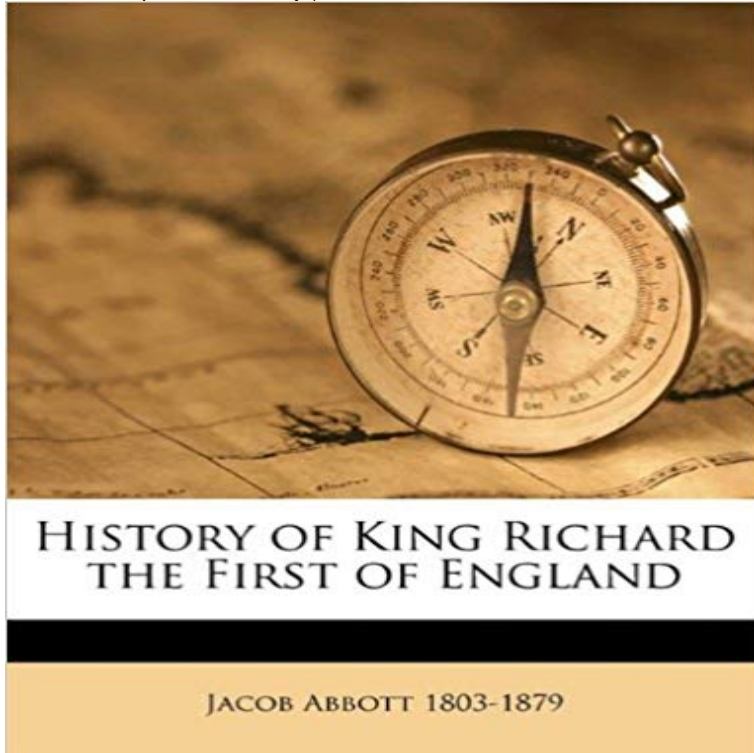


# History of King Richard the First of England
