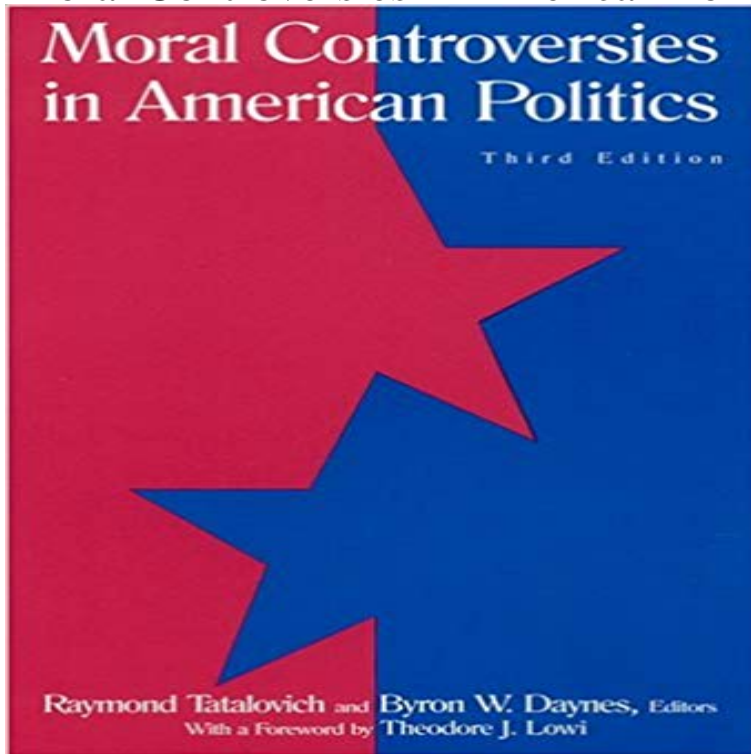


Moral Controversies in American Politics
