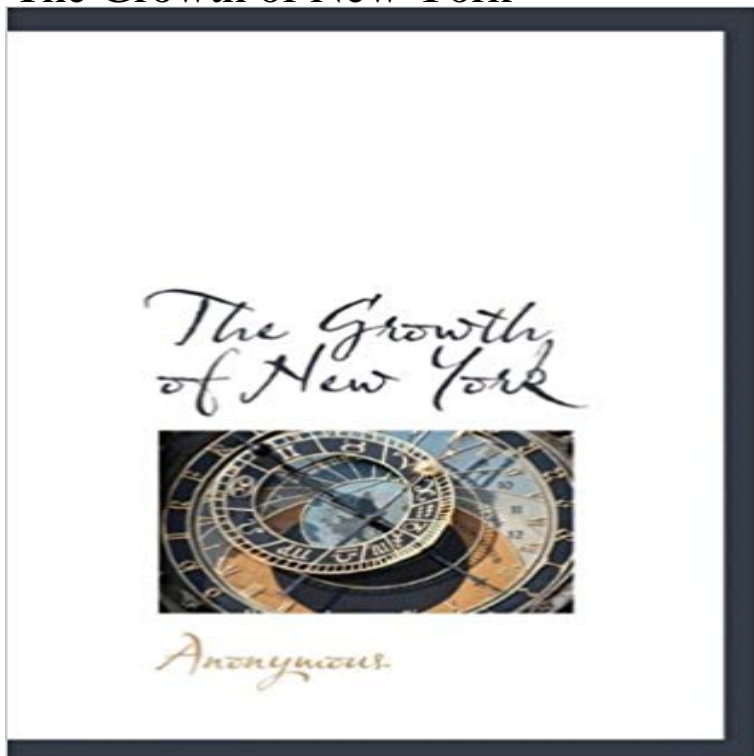


The Growth of New York
