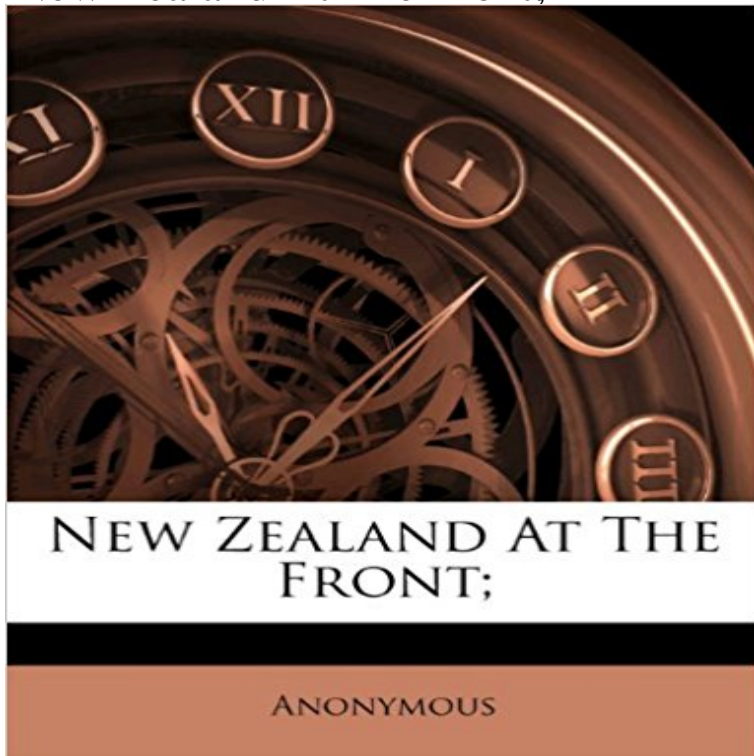


## New Zealand At The Front;
