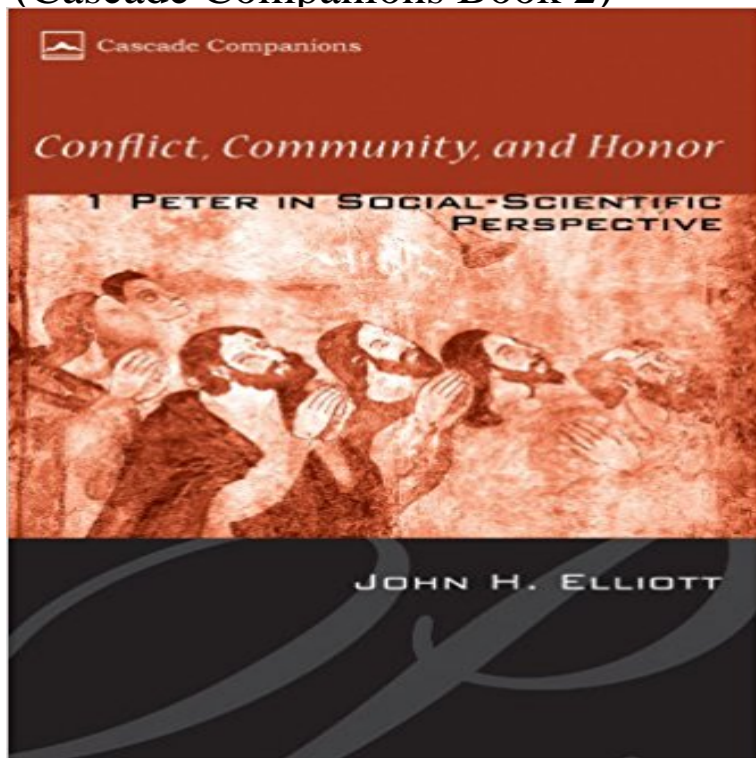


Conflict, Community, and Honor: 1 Peter in Social-Scientific Perspective (Cascade Companions Book 2)
