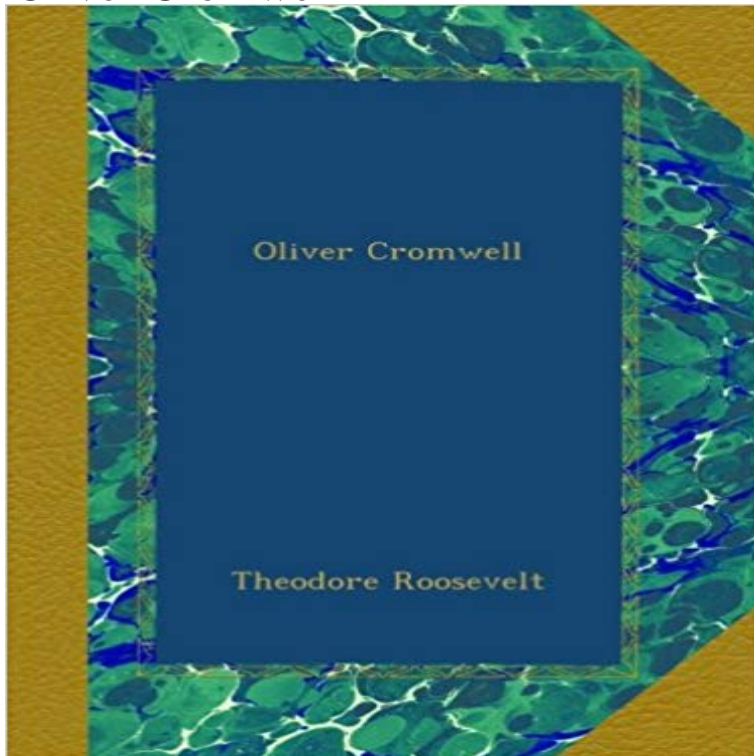


Oliver Cromwell
