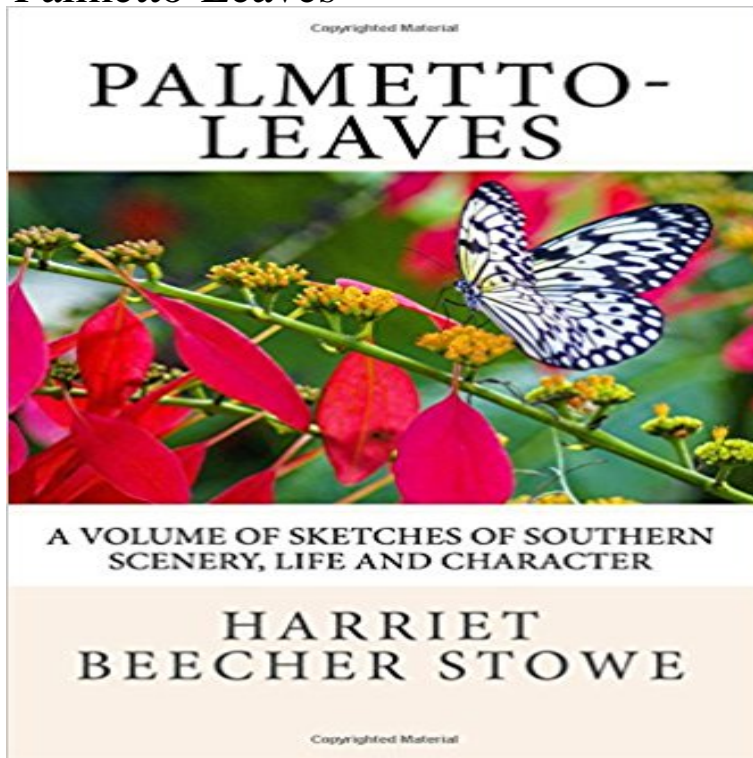


Palmetto-Leaves
