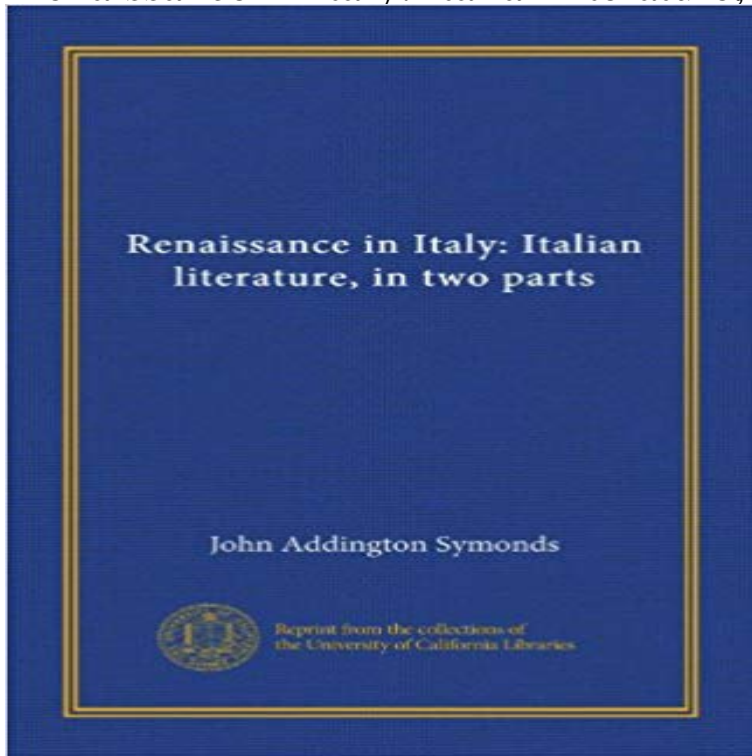


## Renaissance in Italy: Italian literature, in two parts (v.2)
