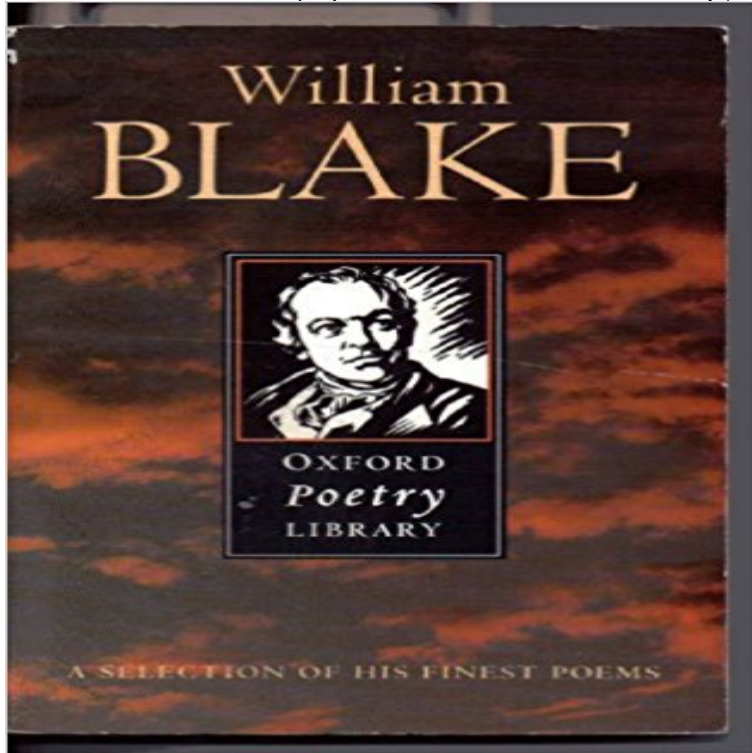


Selected Poetry (Worlds Classics Eighteenth-Century British Literature)
