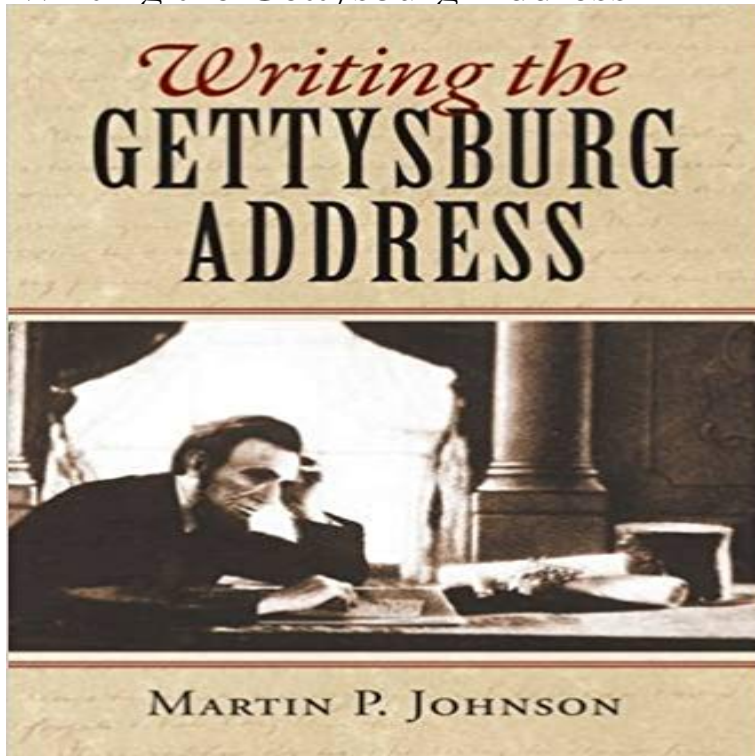


Writing the Gettysburg Address



Four score and seven years ago Are any six words better known, of greater import, or from a more crucial moment in our nations history? His two-minute speech made the battlefield and the cemetery into

landmarks of the American imagination, but it was Lincolns own journey to Gettysburg that made the Gettysburg Address.
