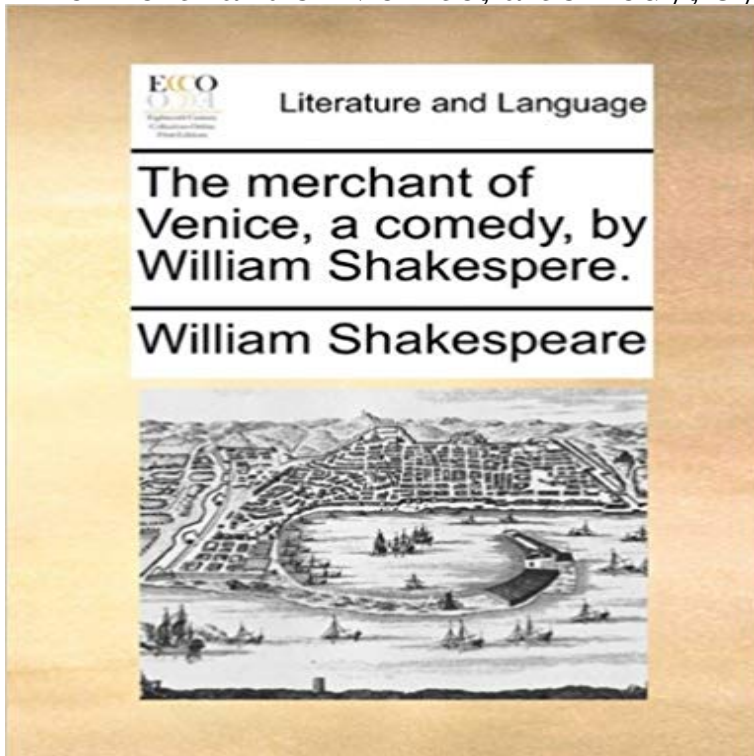


The merchant of Venice, a comedy, by William Shakespere.
