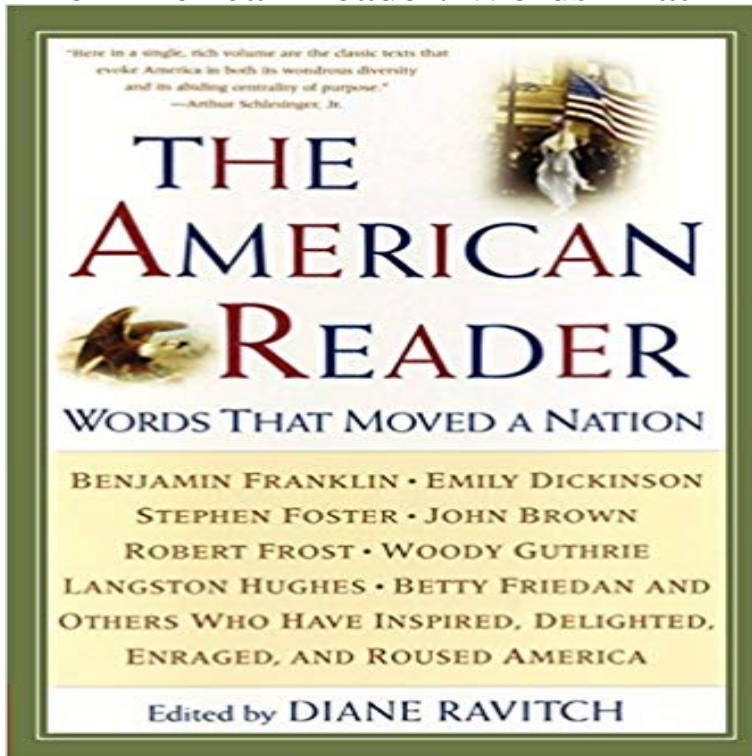


The American Reader: Words That Moved a Nation
