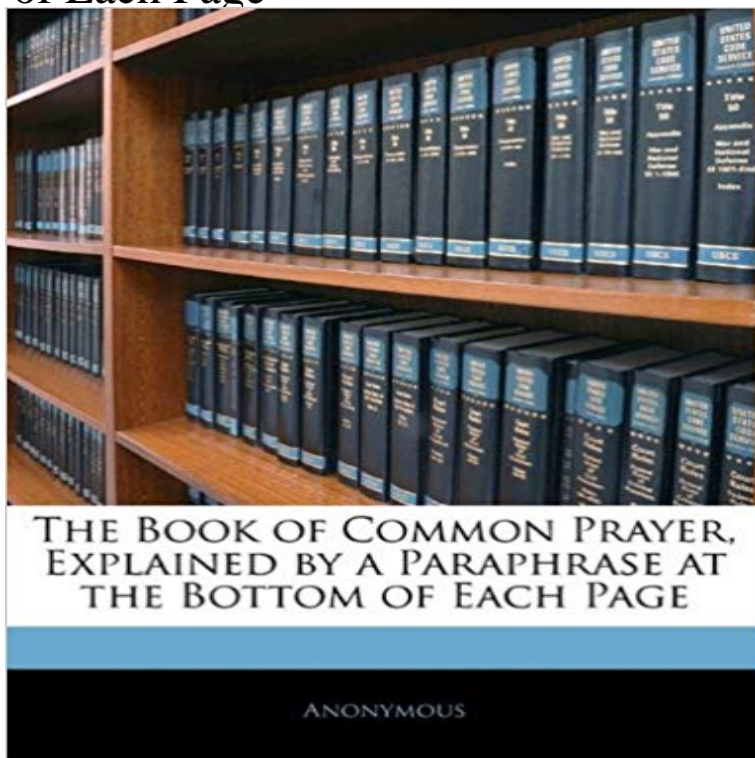


The Book of Common Prayer, Explained by a Paraphrase at the Bottom of Each Page
