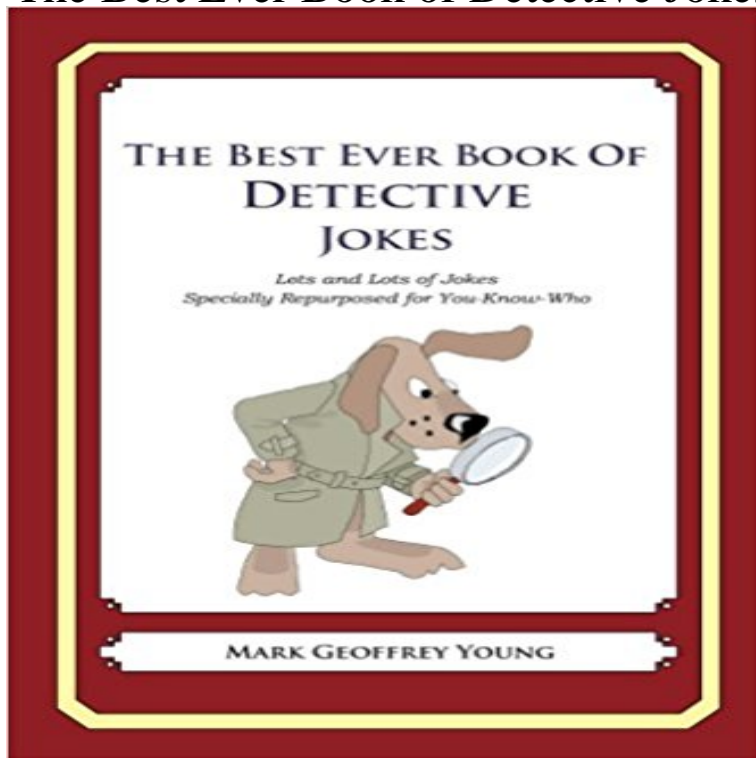


The Best Ever Book of Detective Jokes
