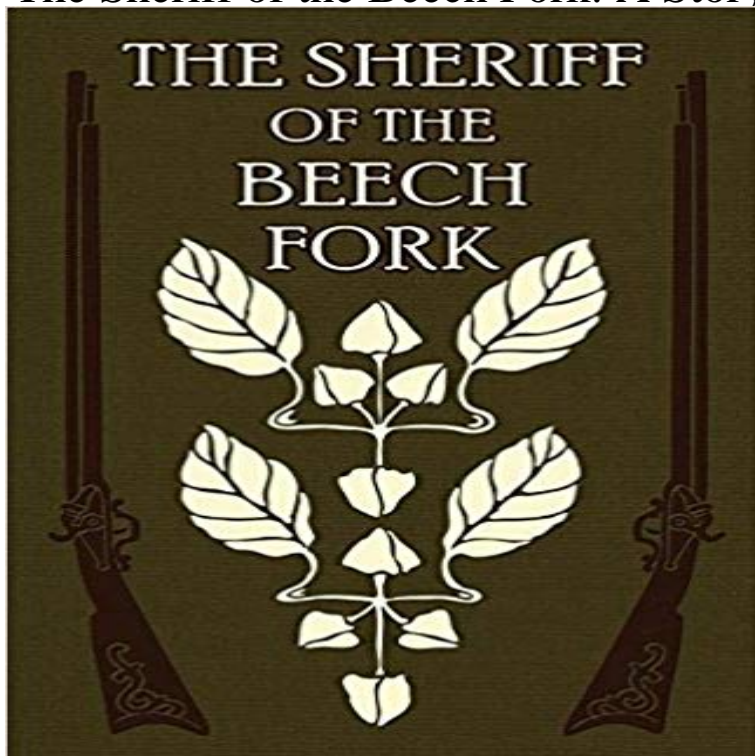


The Sheriff of the Beech Fork: A Story of Kentucky
