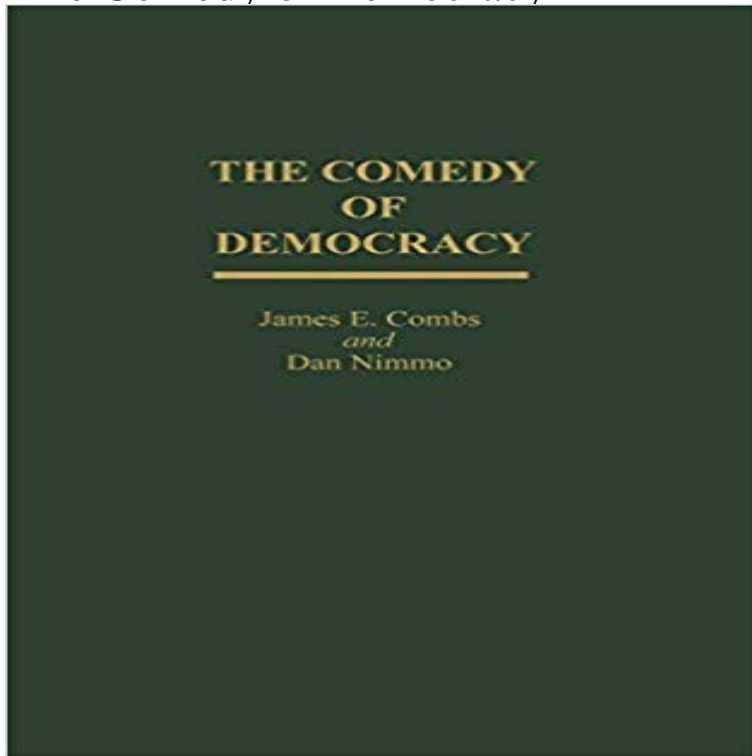


The Comedy of Democracy
