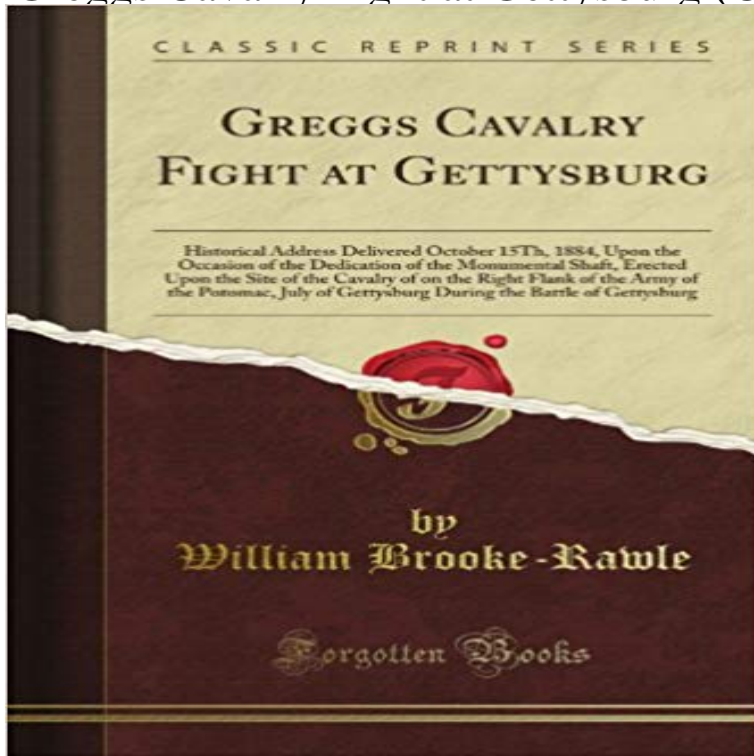

Page 10, twenty-first line. This should read, had spent the latter part of the night of July 2d, c. Page II, ninth line. The words lo A. M. were, most probably, intended for io -clock. As there was no fighting so early in the day as loo clock in the morning, it was suggested by General Kidd, in a note to his address delivered June 12th, 1889, at the dedication of the monument erected by the State of Michigan to the Michigan Cavalry Brigade (who, ifl giving an account of the operations, found a difficulty in reconciling General Custer sstatement to the facts), that General Custer originally wrote to clock, and in the copying of the report the i and theo were mistaken for 10. This seems to be the correct solution of the matttr. The report is not printed in the Official Records of the War of the Rebellion, inasmuch as the original is not on file in the War Department, and it was found impossible to obtain it or a duly authenticated copy of it. The report is printed in Moore s Rebellion Record, volume 7, page 379. Page 17, eleventh line. This should read, As soon as the Michigan brigade had begun to move oflF, c. Page 17, last line and note, and page 18, first line. The other portions of the regiment were deployed to the right Captain Miller ssquadron (with which that of Captain Newhall, who was acting as Assistant A djutant-G eneral of McIntosh sbrigade, was temporarily consolidated) on the left of the cross-country road, and Captains Walsh sand Hess squadrons on the right of it.
