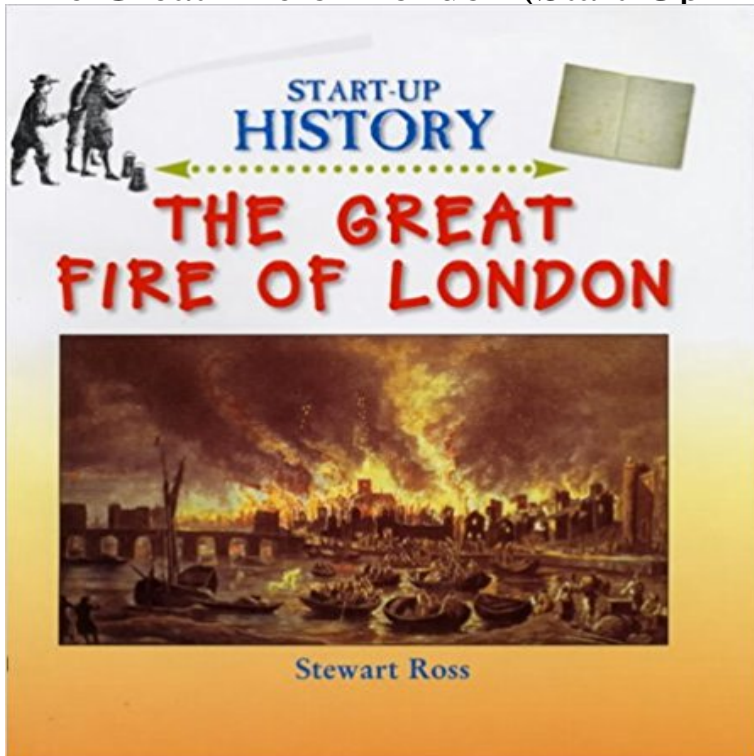


The Great Fire of London (Start-Up History)
