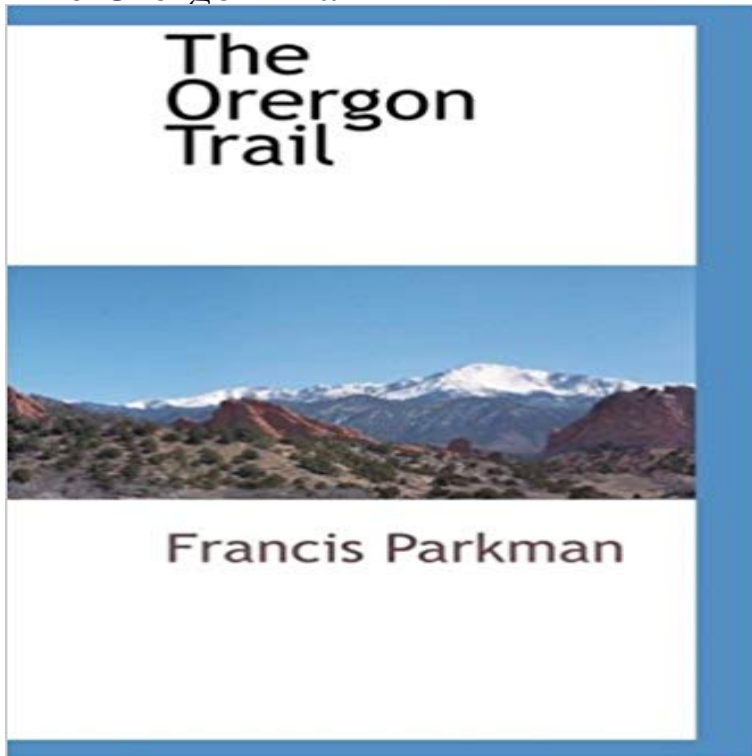


The Oregon Trail
