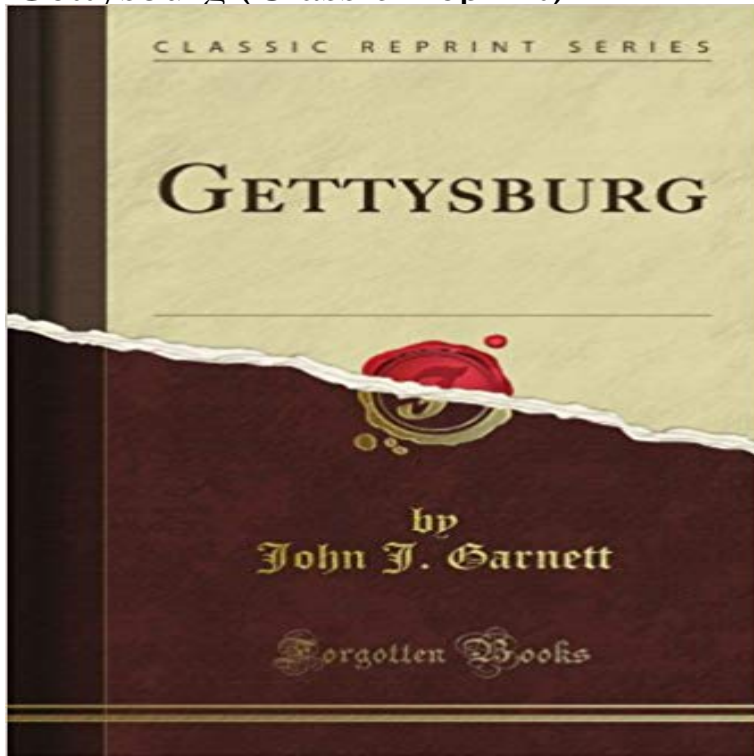


Gettysburg (Classic Reprint)
