
Translation Nation: American Identity in the Spanish-Speaking United States

By the end of the book, we have traveled from the geographical extremes into the heartland, exploring the familiar complexities of Cuban Miami and the brand-new ones of a busy Omaha INS Sophisticated, provocative, and station. human. Translation deeply Nation uncovers the ways that Hispanic Americans are forging new identities, redefining the experience of the American

immigrant, and reinventing the American community. It is a book that rises, brilliantly, to meet one of the most profound shifts in American identity.
