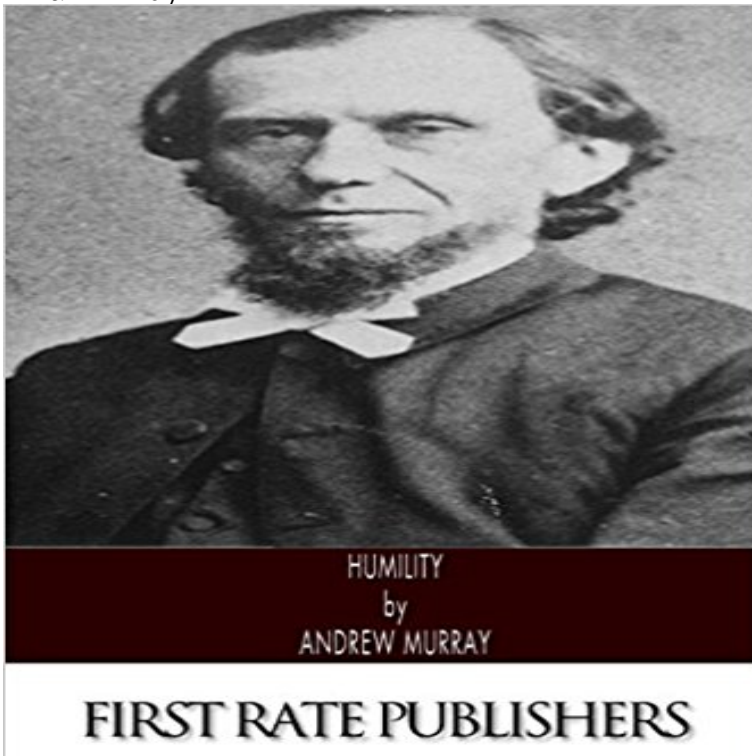


Humility
